MINUTE ORDER: It is hereby ORDERED that the parties shall appear for a Telephone Conference on May 31, 2018 at 2:00 PM. It is further ORDERED that Defendants and their counsel shall: (1) continue to work with the DOD and USCIS to explore ways to avoid the need for two FBI background checks; (2) seek further information from USCIS sufficient to enable counsel to explain to the Court why providing USCIS with MANVI ship dates would not help USCIS to more efficiently schedule naturalization interviews; (3) confer with USCIS about drafting an email or other communication from the field directorate to the field offices that reinforces the July 7th Policy and reiterates that the processing of naturalization applications, including scheduling naturalization interviews for MANVIs, should not be delayed; and (4) respond to Plaintiffs' counsel regarding the solutions proposed in Plaintiffs' May 21, 2018 email to Chambers in an effort to work towards mutually agreeable solutions.
