ORDER

On June 20, 2018, Judge Huvelle referred to the undersigned the parties’ dispute regarding “the May 17, 2018 USCIS Guidance’s admissibility as an appendix to plaintiffs’ motion for summary judgment.” 6/20/2018 Order, ECF No. 159. For the reasons stated in the Memorandum Opinion docketed contemporaneously with this Order, it is this 16th day of July, 2018, hereby:

ORDERED that the May 18, 2018 Guidance shall be admissible as an appendix to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Summary Judgment, subject to the redactions identified in the contemporaneously docketed Memorandum Opinion;

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that the May 2018 Guidance shall be designated as “Protected Material,” and subject to the limitations on the use and distribution of “Protected Material” that are set forth in the Protective Order governing this case. *See generally* Order Granting Mot. for Protective Order, ECF No. 123.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that United States Citizenship and Immigration Service (“USCIS”) shall produce a redacted version of the May 18, 2018 Guidance to Plaintiffs’ counsel on or before July 23, 2018.
