See Exhibit ("Ex.") A, *Nio* Class Report.<sup>3</sup>

USCIS and DoD have identified approximately 1,416 present *Nio* class members. See Ex. A. All of the members of the *Nio* class have submitted naturalization applications, because the class is defined to include only those MAVNI soldiers who have submitted naturalization applications. (ECF No. 72). The spreadsheet indicates the dates those N-400 applications were submitted. 171 *Nio* class members have completed the naturalization interview, and 140 class members have naturalization interviews scheduled with USCIS.

Since Defendants' June 6, 2018 monthly report, ECF No. 153:

1. 65 *Nio* class members have naturalized;
2. 135 *Nio* class members have been scheduled for a USCIS naturalization interview and;
3. 43 have received an MSSD determination uploaded to the shared portal with USCIS.

Exhibit B contains all of the names and naturalization dates for the approximately 244 former *Nio* class members who are now United States citizens (as of July 3, 2018). This spreadsheet also contains names of two former class members whose naturalization applications were denied (including a former class member who withdrew his application before USCIS was notified of his MSSD), and two former class members whose naturalization applications were administratively closed.
