Class member [PII REDACTED] (Defendants’ Report Excerpt below) was interviewed for naturalization on October 16, 2019 at the Boston Field Office. The soldier reported that the USCIS officer told him that the officer wanted to review the soldier’s MSSR report and unit close order (in connection with the closure of his unit and his unit transfer). After the interview, the soldier received an RFE regarding his honorable military service (see attached) – asking the soldier to provide his MSSR report and proof of honorable military service. As you know, USCIS already has all of the DoD background check information for this soldier and all others. And, there are no further “service” requirements beyond what this soldier already has, as exhibited by the N-426 submitted with the N-400. We attach a copy of the N-26 for your reference.

Please ensure that all relevant USCIS personnel understand the Court’s orders in this case and the related cases. And, please confirm by email that USCIS is not waiting on any additional information about this soldier’s background checks, past military service, or any future military service before making a decision on this soldier’s application. Finally, please ensure that the officer on this case fairly adjudicates this application notwithstanding any personal views the officer may have as to what constitutes military service.
